

# Frequently Asked Questions: 2020 APRU Global Health Poster Contest

## **Do I have to register and make any payment if I want to join the Student Poster Contest?**

All students of any university can submit a poster which must be related to global health and unpublished at the time of submission. Whether the poster submitter registers or participates in the conference is not part of our selection criteria.

## **Do I have to be a current student?**

Yes, you should be enrolled at a university in 2020. You are eligible to submit if you graduated in the spring or summer of 2020.

## **Do I need to come from an APRU member university?**

No, this competition is open to all students from any university.

## **Do I need to submit an abstract or the actual poster?**

Students should submit their actual poster for judging.

## **Can I include more than one author's name on my poster?**

Yes, you are welcome to include co-authors' names, including mentors. However, the name of the first author should be the student that is entering the contest.

## **Can multiple students submit one poster as co-authors?**

Yes, but the first person listed on the poster will be considered the winner.

## **When will I be notified about whether my student poster was accepted?**

All student posters are considered to "accepted" and will be displayed in some way (virtually or through a conference program).

## **When will I be notified if I am a winner of the Student Poster Contest?**

The top 3 finalists will be selected for each of the undergraduate and graduate categories and released on October 1. The winners (one in each category) will be announced at the virtual Global Health Conference on October 19-21.

**Will late posters be considered?**

The submission deadline is **September 1, 2020 at 11:59pm Pacific time**. Late submissions will not be accepted.

**Where do I submit my poster?**

In your email, please include whether you are an undergraduate or graduate student and your field of study. If you are submitting on behalf of more than one student, please also indicate that.

**Will I receive a certificate of participation?**

Yes, within 30 days after the conference, we will email a certificate to all participants.
