

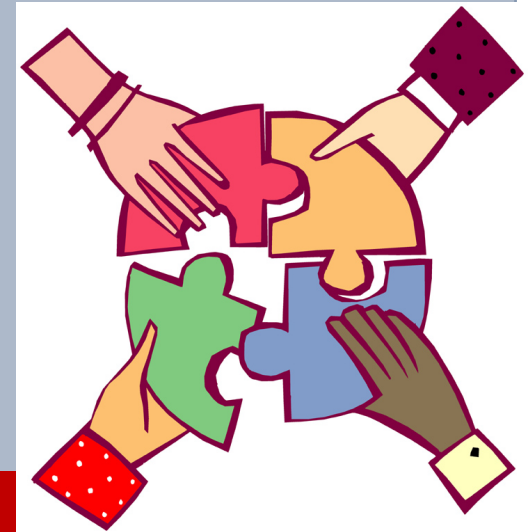


# Mini Certificate in Health Research Ethics
